- Manage Packhouse: Inventory, cleaning, supplies, organization, food safety
- Rinse, bunch, pack, prepare, and quality control vegetables
- Oversee CSA pack line
- Clean, mill, and pack Heritage grains
- Prepare and pack market trucks
- Lead crews and manage work stations in all of the above areas
- Record-keeping, planning, and preparing
- Bilingual preferred
- Flexible teamwork: Work and communicate well with our team to keep the whole farm organism running smoothly, including flexibility to jump in where/when needed, such as Farm Stand or Harvest

Schedule & Compensation:

March/April - November/December, Mon-Fri. **\$20-\$22/hr** DOE + staff veggies. **Experience required** (farm, grocery, restaurant, etc). 40-55 hours/week depending on season and farm needs, with OT pay over 40. That's right - you get time-and-a-half pay for all hours over 40!

Benefits: Bonus pay twice during the season for all full-time, full-season staff in their second year of employment at Aspen Moon! You'll earn 1 hour bonus pay for every 40 hours worked.
